She made the words and the philosophy of Nelson Mandela "you are the master of your destiny", her own life philosophy. She strongly believes one must always be proud of who you are, regardless of what other people may see as deficiencies. Shéri Brynard gives meaning to her life by trying to raise awareness of the abilities of people with Down syndrome in South Africa and abroad. Shéri tries to change negative perceptions about people with Down syndrome and she is an activist to give all people with Down syndrome the same opportunities they would have had, if they were fully abled. She also tries to help the so called normal people in her audiences to focus on the positive things in their own lives. She truly believes that all people have the ability to choose to make the best of their circumstances and she is the living example of that. A true leader inspires others and does not give up hope, ever. This is what Sheri Brynard did.
