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## Effectiveness in the answer of pain management perception related to clinical reasoning of the nursing team

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The patient's experience is a personal assessment of health services that aggregates indicators of care quality. One of these indicators is pain management and control which becomes a latent nurse's concern with the characterization of painful experience in all its domains (biological, emotional and behavioral). Pain perception is a complex variable that negatively impacts the patient's experience. The objective of the study was to measure the patient's perception of pain management by the intensity score (moderate to high). The study was conducted at the surgical units of a private hospital accredited by the Joint Commission Accreditation Health Care Certification (JCAHO) in a pre-determined period in 2017 with a sample of 48 patients. It is a quantitative approach about the perception of care time and the therapeutic response to pain through the application of a form. In the preliminary analysis of data, the perception regarding administration time of analgesic in pain relief was five minutes in majority of the patients (47.9%). In particular, 77% had a good perception of effectiveness in applied therapy. Results showed the minimum acceptable time for pain management for the evaluated patients' profile and the nursing team's service in pain resolution. Education and training in assessment and therapeutics pain influence the team's clinical reasoning for appropriate therapy and impact on pain management indicators and patient's experience.
