It is based on biomedical research and clinical evidence collected over the past 40 years. Periosteal Acupuncture workshop is a clinical modality for pain management which permits the practitioners to implement medical acupuncture in an unprecedented short time in their daily practice. The workshop will help them to understand and incorporate medical acupuncture as an adjunct therapy to their daily practice without undergoing the complex and time-consuming process of learning antiquated procedures of the empirical model of classical acupuncture.
