New Advances in the reconciliation vessel's research

Analyzing the properties of the reconciliation vessel, new questions raised about the origin of this Wondrous Circuit, as well as its configuration through the philosophical and cosmological basis of Traditional Chinese Medicine. Scrutinizing its location within Fu Hsi's octogram and according to the I-Ching and Yellow Emperor's coincidences in Ling Shu and Su Wen quotations, a plausible explanation rose up from a detailed methodological work embodied in this paper.
