He has published 8 books in the Persian language and two chapters in English abroad, nearly 200 papers in reputed journals, and supervised 25 Ph.D. and more than 60 in MSc., Now he is on duty at the Union Medicinal Plants of Iran (Chairman, UMPI) and Iranian Medicinal Plants Society (Board member, IMPS).
