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Managing a severe case of Dentinogenesis imperfecta, a pediatric life challenge

Objective:

To present the Dental management of a 5 years old child complained of dental malformation secondary to Dentinogenesis Imperfecta (DI).

The dental management is challenging especially in younger patients. The dental status was severe that all the teeth had to be treated with modification of the routine in pedodontics.
