Satisfaction of 2nd year nursing students toward using program simulation instructional media for injection

This study aimed to explore the satisfaction of 2nd year nursing students toward using Program Simulation Instructional Media for injection who are enrolled to studied in Fundamental Nursing Laboratory course. The sample of this study consisted of 72 students. Data was collected by using personal data questionnaires and the satisfaction towards the program. The reliability of Cronbach's Alpha Coefficient were 0.94. The data were analysis based on descriptive statistics.

The findings, satisfaction toward using Program Simulation Instructional Media for Injection was at high level ($\bar{x} = 4.04$, $S.D.=1.43$). Moreover, satisfaction for the content meets the needs of the program user also at high level ($\bar{x} = 4.19$, $S.D.=0.93$), The clarity of function of the media also at high level ($\bar{x} = 3.99$, $S.D.=1.42$). Finally, for the easy of using the program, there were at high level ($\bar{x} = 3.83$, $S.D.=0.66$) as well.
