The oral pathology global market is expected to have a healthy growth rate in the forecast period (2012-2025). National oral surgeons care expenditures were \$113.5 billion in 2014, somewhat up from \$112 billion in 2013 (in inflation-adjusted 2014 dollars) but roughly considered the same level. The global oral care/oral hygiene market is projected to reach USD 53.97 Billion by 2022 from USD 43.31 Billion in 2017, at a CAGR of 4.5%.

The ADTA report clearly suggests that staff shifts and changes will force the design and construction of new practice/organizational models that have "insurgent" staffing concepts and dynamic cultures — if the dentist is willing to embrace the full spectrum of provider

choices! With the rapid technological advancement, wide range of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology techniques, and increase in the need of pathology automation. Oral health is essential to general health and quality of life. From past few years, the oral surgeons market is relatively stable, with substantial growth in restorative CAD/CAM dentistry.
