

Editorial Note for Journal of Pollution

Introduction

I am pleased to mention that during the year 2019, all issues of volume 2 were published online well within the time and the print issues were also brought out and dispatched within 30 days of publishing the issue online.

During the calendar year 2019, HGEC received a total of 57 papers, out of which 44 articles (80%) were rejected in the preliminary screening due to plagiarism or being out of the format and peer review process. During 2019 around 10 articles were subjected for publication after they are accepted in the peer review process. In the 2 issues of Volume 2 published during the year 2019, a total of 8 articles were published (at an average of 4 articles per issue) of which, articles were published from authors all around the world. A total of 50 research scientists from all over the world reviewed the 8 articles published in volume 8. Average publication lag time of an article was further reduced to 2-3 weeks.

During the calendar year 2019, a total of 20 Editors, 50 Reviewers joined the board of journal of pollution and contributed their invaluable services towards contribution as well as publication of articles. Journal of Pollution encourages original research and presents significant environmental pollution issues contributing to knowledge share and dissemination. The editors welcome high quality papers where the pollutants are clearly defined and measured and can

be directly related to biological, ecological, and human health effects. This comprises of air, water, soil pollution and climate change cause of them, new techniques and measurement of pollutants and pollutant effects with new types of environmental challenges like pollution antibiotic resistances of organisms.

Journal of Pollution publishes research articles, case reports, short communications, images, editorials, critical review papers and commentaries along with letters to the editor. Articles on innovative techniques and measurements to combat global problems are welcome.

I take this opportunity to acknowledge the contribution of Dr. RAGHAVA R. KOMMALAPATI, during the final editing of articles published and the support rendered by the editorial assistant, Shubo Deng in bringing out issues of HGEC in time. I would also like to express my gratitude to all the authors, reviewers, the publisher, the advisory and the editorial board of Journal of Pollution, the office bearers for their support in bringing out yet another volume of Journal of Pollution and look forward to their unrelenting support to bring out the Volume 3 of Journal of Pollution in scheduled time.
