Dear Readers, I am pleased to mention that during the year 2019, all issues of volume 8 were published online well within the time and the print issues were also brought out and dispatched within 30 days of publishing the issue online. Journal of Applied & Computational Mathematics (JACM) successfully released issues in 2019. It is the most preferred and highly accessed Journal in the field science where computing plays a central and essential role in emphasizing algorithms, numerical methods and symbolic methods with the concept of ubiquitous computing. The journal provides an Open Access platform to analyze new computational and applied techniques for solving the scientific or engineering problems. The Journal is indexed in Index Copernicus, Google Scholar, Sherpa Romeo, Open J Gate and among many other reputed scientific databases. At many instances members of the editorial board also prefer to submit their articles. Such practice is common in other reputed specialty Journals. The submissions to the journal are subjected to peerreview process by the editorial board members or external subject experts. The complete editorial processing of the manuscript is done through the integrated online editorial manuscript submission and review system for greater transparency and faster article throughout. During 2019 around 24 articles were subjected to the peer-review process and 15 of those were accepted. In the volume 8 published during the year 2019, a total of 15 articles were published (at an average of 3 articles per issue) of which, 40 % articles were by foreign authors. A total of 106 research scientists from India and abroad reviewed the 15 articles published in volume 8. Average publication lag time of an article was further reduced to 6-8 months. I take this opportunity to acknowledge the contribution of Orlando Gomes during the final editing of articles published and the support rendered by the editorial assistant, in bringing out issues of the journal in time. I would also like to express my gratitude to all the authors, reviewers, the publisher, the advisory and the editorial board of IME, the office bearers and staff for their support in bringing out yet another volume of the journal and look forward to their unrelenting support to bring out the Volume 9 of JACM in scheduled time.
