It is our pleasure to announce that during year 2020, all issues of volume 12 were published online on time and the print issues were also brought out and dispatched within 30 days of publishing the issue online.

All published articles of this journal are included in the indexing and abstracting coverage of CAS Source Index (CASSI), Index Copernicus, Google Scholar, Sherpa Romeo, RefSeek, China National Knowledge Infrastructure (CNKI), Directory of Research Journal Indexing (DRJI), Hamdard University, EBSCO A-Z, OCLC-WorldCat, SWB online catalog, Publons, Authors having NIH grant were submitted to PubMed (PubMed NLM ID: 101550236).

During the calendar year 2019, JBABM received a total of 21 papers, out of which 6 articles were rejected in the preliminary screening due to plagiarism or being out of the format and peer review process. During 2019 around 10 articles were subjected for publication after they are accepted in the peer review process. In the 6 issues of Volume 11 published during the year 2019, a total of 10 articles were published (at an average of 2 articles per issue) of which, articles were published from authors all around the world. A total of 50 research scientists from all over the world reviewed the 10 articles published in volume 11. Average publication lag time of an article was further reduced to 2-3 weeks.
