

Editor's Note on Journal of Clinical Research

Dear Readers,

I am pleased to mention that during the year 2019, all issues of volume 3 were published online well within the time and the print issues were also brought out and dispatched within 30 days of publishing the issue online.

Our greatest strength lies in the gold open access mode of publishing enabling the content accessible to the remotest corners of the world absolutely free of charge. The constituent journals, mentored by an internationally acclaimed editorial team regularly publish peer-reviewed content in all formats of scientific reporting covering major specializations of clinical and medical science. Consequently our journal productions appear in several indexing databases and are very popular among academicians, researchers, students, medical and pharmaceutical industry.

JCRE sets the standards for the clinical practices and clinical trials, by publishing the latest innovations as research articles, review articles, case studies, short communication, commentaries and the letters to the editor.

Reviewers can access, read and download full length manuscript and submit their opinions. Editors can oversee and operate the entire cycle of screening, revisions, editing of the submissions. Publishers can monitor the submissions and channelize production operations such as copy editing, style sheet implementation and author proof generation.

JCRE caters to the requirements of wide spectrum of researchers who are clinical practitioners, diagnostic professionals, medical practitioners, pharmacists, chemists and druggists and the institutions engaged in academic and research practices in clinical trials and clinical research

Journal of Clinical Research (JCRE) successfully released 8 issues with 45 abstracts. The submissions to the journal are subjected to peer-review process by the editorial board members or external subject experts. The complete editorial processing of the manuscript is done through the integrated online editorial manuscript submission and review system for greater transparency and faster article throughout. During 2019 around 30 articles were subjected to the peer-review process and 45 of those were accepted.

In the volume 4 published during the year 2019, a total of 45 articles were published (at an average of 4 articles per issue) of which, 50 % articles were by foreign authors. A total of 236 research scientists from India and abroad reviewed the 45 articles published in volume 3. Average publication lag time of an article was further reduced to 6-8 months.

I take this opportunity to acknowledge the contribution of **Sutep Jaruratasirikul** during the final editing of articles published and the support rendered by the editorial assistant, in bringing out issues of JCRE in time.

I would also like to express my gratitude to all the authors, reviewers, the publisher, the advisory and the editorial board of JCRC, the office bearers and staff for their support in bringing out yet another volume of JCRC and look forward to their unrelenting support to bring out the Volume 4 of JCRC in scheduled time.
