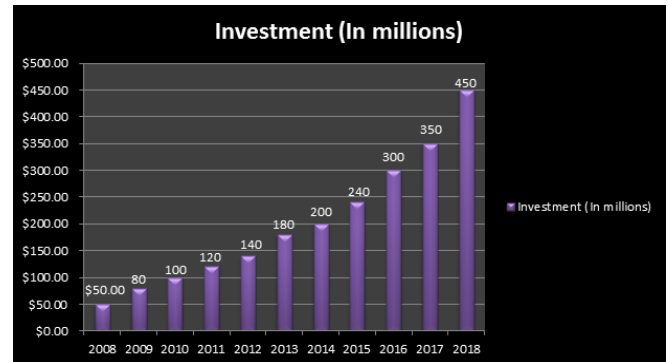
The German nursing home show was to a large extent determined by major portfolio transactions in the investment year now gone. The two in the year's largest exchange consisting of France's Primonial REIM acquiring a portfolio of [nursing homes](#) containing 68 nursing homes from Even Capital, an outstanding bid of almost € 1 billion added to the overall volume of trade.

The two second largest portfolio bargains with CBRE exhorting the investor for each situation also represent an enormous part of the outcome of the current year. 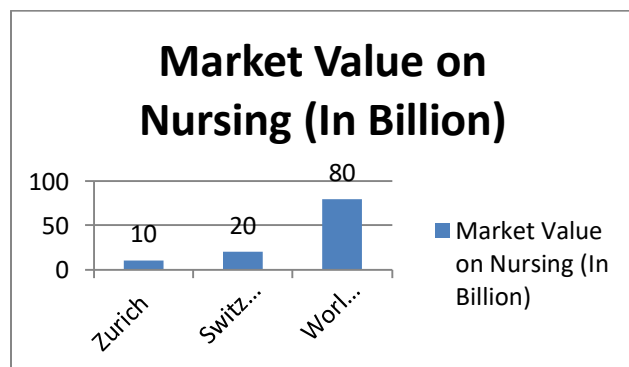

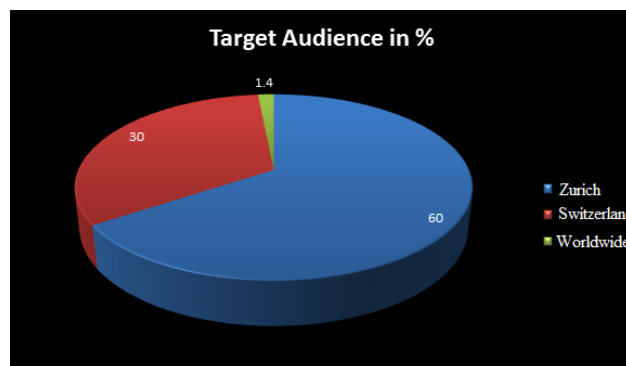
